Tufts Wildlife Clinic is a full service wildlife hospital with two staff clinicians, intern, and veterinary technician. Externs work with Tufts students to assume primary responsibility for case management of sick, injured, and orphaned native wildlife. The Wildlife Clinic admits approximately 1600 cases/year; approximately 60% birds, 25% mammals, 10- 15% reptiles and amphibians.
